Successful candidates will be expected to teach graduate-level courses (in-person and online); participate in developing and launching a professional doctorate in organizational leadership; actively engage in research, publication, and workshop development and presentation; advise master and doctoral students; perform service to the university through committee membership; support assessment efforts; and collaborate across departments and/or schools at the University.
